Captain Kaialii Kahele distinguished himself by meritorious achievement while participating in sustained aerial flight as C-130H Copilot, 774th Expeditionary Airlift Squadron, 376th Expeditionary Operations Group, 376th Air Expeditionary Wing, Manas Air Base, Kyrgyz Republic, from 17 September 2005 to 17 October 2005. During this period, Captain Kahele directly contributed to national security objectives by flying missions in support of Operations ENDURING FREEDOM and the war on terrorism in Afghanistan. The airmanship and courage of Captain Kahele were instrumental in the safe completion of 14 combat missions flown into austere combat airfields. Many of these missions were conducted at night under the threat of hostile fire, with minimal navigation aids and in inclement weather.
