CONGRESSMAN SETH MOULTON ENDORSES KAI KAHELE FOR CONGRESS

[HONOLULU] – Massachusetts Congressman and former Presidential candidate, Seth Moulton (D), through his political organization Serve America, announced his endorsement of Sen. Kai Kahele's candidacy for Congress today:

"I am happy to endorse Kai Kahele for Hawai'i's Second Congressional District. The 2nd Congressional District encompasses Hawai'i Island, Maui, Kaho'olawe, Moloka'i, Lāna'i, Kaua'i, Ni'ihau and the rural parts of O'ahu, including Waimānalo, Kailua, Kāne'ohe, the North Shore, and the Leeward coast.
