KAHELE CAMPAIGN TEMPORARILY SUSPENDS PUBLIC FUNDRAISING EVENTS FOR MARCH

HILO, HAWAI'I – Out of an abundance of caution and in the best interest of all our friends and supporters, we have made the decision to temporarily cancel all public fundraising events for the remainder of the month of March.

We are encouraging everyone to help "flatten the curve" by adhering to the following protective measures:

- Wash your hands often with soap and water for at least 20 seconds, especially after going to the bathroom; before eating; and after blowing your nose, coughing, or sneezing.
- If soap and water are not readily available, use an alcohol-based hand sanitizer with at least 60% alcohol. Always wash hands with soap and water if hands are visibly dirty.
- Avoid touching your eyes, nose, and mouth with unwashed hands.
- Avoid close contact with people who are sick.
- Stay home if you are sick.
- Cover your cough or sneeze with a tissue; then throw the tissue in the trash.
- Clean and disinfect frequently touched objects and surfaces using a regular household cleaning spray or wipe.
- Practice social distancing: forgo hugs and handshakes, throw a shaka when greeting someone.

We are actively working on ways to support the many rural communities impacted by this pandemic. This health crisis only emphasizes why Hawai'i's Congressional District 2 needs a full-time and active representative in Washington D.C.
