HGEA ENDORSES KAI KAHELE FOR CONGRESS

HONOLULU – Hawai'i Government Employees Association, the state's largest union, announced its early endorsement of **Kai Kahele** for Congress today. Kai is a candidate for Hawaii's 2nd Congressional District.

"HGEA's Political Action Committee sees Kai as someone who will strongly articulate Hawaii's needs and concerns in Washington, D.C.," said **HGEA executive director Randy Perreira**. "We believe he will be a true asset to our congressional delegation."

Kai is a proud union member of the Air Line Pilots Association. He believes that elected leaders cannot turn a blind eye to the dangers of climate change, global warming and natural disasters and he pledges to govern with knowledge and courage.

Kahele serves as Majority Floor Leader and Chairman of the Committee on Water and Land in the Hawai'i State Senate where he represents his hometown of Hilo. He is an 18-year combat veteran aviator who was recently promoted to the rank of Lieutenant Colonel in the Hawai'i Air National Guard.

The 2nd Congressional District encompasses Hawai'i Island, Maui, Kaho'olawe, Moloka'i, Lāna'i, Kaua'i, Ni'ihau and the rural parts of O'ahu, including Waimānalo, Kailua, Kāne'ohe, the North Shore, and the Leeward coast.
